The March 11, 2016 minutes were reviewed. The minutes will be amended to add Tricia Larson to those who were present.

Melissa reviewed the Forces of Change report for Peoria County. The Committee accepted the report.

Amy provided an overview of the Partnership for a Health Community group and the discussions the health departments have had to-date with its membership. Amy elaborated on the background and history of the group including how it related to HCI/Quality Quest and the Community Transformation Grants (CTG). The Partnership is in favor of transferring the leadership of the group to the health departments and using MAPP and the Community Health Improvement Plan as the roadmap that guides the implementation process and activities of the group. The Committee supported the health departments in moving forward.

The Community Health Needs Assessment will be released by the hospitals in September. It's hoped that there will be media, press releases, and joint presentation of the data and plan.

The Illinois Department of Public Health is looking closely at our tri-county process as it is a first for the State. That said, they are particularly interested in accountability for the work of the plan and how it will be shared across the health departments. MOUs were discussed.

The next step in the MAPP process is writing the Community Health Improvement Plan. A working draft has been mocked up. The improvement planning groups will continue their work developing goals, objectives, strategies and tasks (i.e., the plan) through July and August. A draft report for review is expected in September.
